For closing twist wire boxes & crates



- After the crate is prepared for closing, the wires are bent at right angles to the crate approximately 5/8" from the closing edge.
- The end of the bit is pushed over the wires and against the box or crate. The trigger is pulled and held for about two seconds to form a twist. The tool is then removed from the finished twist.
- After all of the twists are completed, they are knocked against the box or crate - parallel to the binding wire.

Power Twisters, separate bits, and adapters may be obtained from manufacturers of wirebound boxes and from Stapling Machines Co., Rockaway, N.J. When ordering a complete tool, bit, or adapter only, specify the Catalog Number (or Bulletin No. T-14) for the gage of wire to be twisted.
